- The program officially begins Tuesday, June 13th, 2023 and ends Friday, August 4th, 2023. There will be an Awards Ceremony on Wednesday, August 9th, 2023.
- JV Leads must be **at least 18 years old** by Tuesday, June 13th, 2023.
- If you are accepted as a JV lead, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND JV LEAD ORIENTATION AND TRAINING. There will be several dates to choose from.
- JV Leads will participate for a minimum of **two (2) days per week** Tuesday through Friday from **8:30am to 12:30pm**. If you would like to participate but cannot commit to 2 days per week, please contact Mary, APL's Volunteer Coordinator at (217) 544-7387 ext.227 or volunteer@apl-shelter.org.
- JV Leads are integral to the success of this program. You must give the Volunteer Coordinator at least **one week notice** if you will not be able to cover an assigned shift.
- There will be several fundraisers throughout the summer that the JVs and JV Shift Leads will be asked to participate in. These will mainly be on Saturdays and we will distribute schedules and sign-ups after acceptance into the program.
